

## Knots/Lashings Quick Reference Guide

**GOAL:** To provide you with a quick reference guide for those pesky knots and lashings that we forget each year! LOL



### MATERIALS REQUIRED TO MAKE ONE SET:

- 1 or 2 sheets of 8.5 x 11 paper, white or colored, I used blue. 1 sheet is recommended printed double sided.
- Scissors or Exacto Knife and Ruler or Paper Cutter (Exacto knife or paper cutter is preferred as it gives you a much straighter cut)
- Glue Stick if using 2 sheets of paper
- Yarn or string
- Small hole punch - smaller than the standard holes that are punched in lined paper as that size of hole is too big
- Safety pin
- OPTIONAL: You can get the 8.5 x 11 sheet laminated before you cut them out. This will make them much more durable but it's not necessary.

### INSTRUCTIONS:

- Print off page 1 and page 2 double sided on one sheet of paper. Or you can print on two sheets of paper but it will be thicker especially if you laminate them. You may also have to reduce the page a few percentages to print off the cut line marks.
- Once they are assembled or printed double sided cut them out using the provided cut lines and you will end up with 15 pieces per set. I would recommend printing off one set to test that the front and backs line up and that they cut correctly.
- With a small hole punch, punch a hole through all 15 pieces.
- Attach a piece of yard or string through the hole and tie a knot.
- Thread the yarn or string to the safety pin.
- Store on your camp hat or if you have a Tilly hat with a small zipper, you can store inside the camp hat and it's there for whenever you need a quick reference guide.
- This also makes a great Thank You year end or camp gift for others.
